96784	Email	An incorrect message is displayed when an attachment is successfully downloaded.
96836	User interface	Smaller font sizes and more size increments are available.

Good for Enterprise – Android v1.9.0

New Features

- **Good Mobile Access – Secure Browser**¹: Improves productivity with access to critical corporate resources via a secure browser. Browser data is stored and encrypted inside Good for Enterprise. IT controls Intranet access and defines approved domains from Good Mobile Control. Refer to the *Secure Browser User's Guide* for details.
- **Better Email and Calendar User Experience** with the ability to display tentative calendar events in a different color and side-swipe support in calendar.

Notes:

1. Good Mobile Access for Android requires separate download of WebKit from the Android Market. This feature applies only to Android 2.2 and 2.3 devices.

78715	Password	[Sony Xperia x10 Mini and Mini Pro] Native text entry dialog is hiding the number of password attempts left after entering an incorrect password.
79837	Calendar	When editing a recurring meeting on the device, some attendees may not be displayed correctly.
82606	Wipe	[Samsung Infuse and Fascinate, ROM SCH-1500.ED03] When Enterprise Wipe is initiated on a device, it cannot be reprovisioned by uninstalling and reinstalling; the device must be hard reset.
90522	Email	Some blocked (blacklisted) attachments can be forwarded.
91257	Email	If a large attachment or saved file causes a "Low Disk Space" message, Good will become unusable.
91370	Email	When the attachment list in an email is altered and then the email is forwarded, it is never received.

New Features

- **File Repository:** The user can save email attachments securely within the Good for Enterprise application and send them via newly composed email as attachments. Policy settings allow this feature to be enabled/disabled. When enabled, the user can preview, rename, delete, and open documents in third-party applications. Receiving/opening-attachment policies support blocking or allowing untrusted/trusted/ file types into the Good application. (For details, refer to “File Repository” in Chapter 6 of the Good for Enterprise Administrator’s Guide.)*
- **QuickOffice Update :** New version of Quick Office with added features and better PDF file handling. Resolves the following issues:
 - Excel chart embedded inside PowerPoint file (EmbeddedChart.pptx) doesn't display
 - Blank PowerPoint with large background crash with stack trace
 - NullPointerException and crash with stack trace
 - ArrayIndexOutOfBoundsException and crash with stack trace
 - Crash after rotate screen with QO error
- **Log Encryption:** This release supports encrypted client logs on the device and transport of the logs to the Good Mobile Control Console through a secured channel.

Good for Enterprise – Android v1.7.4

New Features

- **File-transferring policy:** Use the new File Transferring policy to specify those third-party applications that users can use with attachments (whitelist) or those that are blocked from receiving attachments from the user (blacklist). Create the attachment list on the Settings page. (Refer to “File Transferring” in the Administrator’s Guide for details.)
- **Send attachment support; blacklisting/whitelisting attachments by extension:** In previous releases, policies supported the blacklisting by extension of *received* attachments. Support is extended in this release to whitelisting and blacklisting for *both received and sent attachments*. Attachments are not added to emails (sent directly through Compose on the handheld; they are added via third-party Open In (send through, or export) facilities. Refer to Messaging in the General Policies section of the Administrator’s Guide for details.
- **Security enhancements:** With this release, the user experience is improved for resetting the Good application password and locking out users from their Good application, remotely from the GMC.
- **Compliance Reporting:** View which devices are not in compliance and know which policies are violated. This feature requires a GMC upgrade. The report appears as a link on the Handheld Info page in GMC.

Good for Enterprise – Android v1.7.3

New features

- **Android 2.2 MDM Support:** Configure and manage policies at the device level. IT can now configure device password requirements, lock screen timeout and remote wipe the entire device. These policies can be applied to a single user, a group of users or the entire organization.
- **Enterprise Application Distribution:** Easily distribute custom or 3rd party enterprise apps outside the Good container to employees. IT uploads applications to the Good Mobile Control server and distributes them to users as a policy setting. Users view a secure catalog of enterprise applications from within the Good for Enterprise application. Users will receive notifications when new applications are available for download.
- **Disable SMS:** For regulated, security-conscious companies, a new security policy that enables IT to disable sending mobile text messages (SMS) from the Good for Enterprise application.
- **ZIP File Attachment:** Mobile users can now download and extract ZIP file attachments from the device. Users will be able to see the table of contents prior to downloading the attachment. Password protected ZIP files are also supported.
- **QuickOffice enhancement:** PDF files will now be opened in the built-in version of QuickOffice, preventing the files from being saved outside the secure enterprise container.
- **Re-Sync:** In the event there is a sync failure, the user will receive a notification and can simply tap a button to re-sync instead of having to re-provision.
- **Personal distribution lists:** Users can now send emails to personal distribution lists from the device.
- **Private Calendar Events:** (Exchange only) Users can mark a meeting as "Private" masking the details of the meeting from admins with delegate access.

-----	Provisioning	[Xoom] The user must remain in the application window while upgrading to this version of Good for Enterprise. Otherwise, it will be necessary to force GFE closed using Settings/Applications/Manage Applications, and to launch the application again.
-----	Email	Over WiFi networks incoming email synchronization may be delayed up to 14 minutes depending on your carrier.
-----	Email	Emails composed on device cannot exceed 7 Kb. End-user will not be asked to reduce the number of characters when trying to send an email over this limit. The body text is silently truncated to 4,000 characters.
-----	Provisioning	When re-provisioning a user, attachments in first 100 emails are not accessible via the handheld.
-----	Utilization	[T-Mobile myTouch 4G Slide] In Settings/Applications for the device, the button for moving Good to the SD card appears to be active. It is not functional. If the user clicks it, the device will appear to move Good to the SD card. Good will remain functional on the device but any Good widgets will be broken. The user can delete the widgets and replace them.
73962	Provisioning	After installation of the Good Client on the device, if the setup process fails at any point after retrieving settings (because a server is down or the device drops its data connection, for example), the Client must be uninstalled and reinstalled before the setup process is retried.
74847	Provisioning	After clearing Good data using Manage Applications on the device, the user is prompted to re-provision when restarting Good, and is required to re-enter username and PIN.
75485	Contacts	Outlook Contacts personal distribution lists may not sync correctly with Good Messaging Contacts on the device.

92211	Application	After upgrading the device, the application icon and email widget may disappear. Workaround: long press on the home screen and select "Widgets" on the menu that is displayed. Scroll down to the Good Widget (there are two, Calendar and Email) that you wish to add. Exception: If you have Ice Cream Sandwich (Android 4.0), tap the apps list soft button to see the full list of apps, and at the top of that screen select the Widgets tab. Find the widget you want, touch and hold to select it, and place it on the home screen.
92603	Secure Browser	Downloading large attachments is not supported within Secure Browser.

This release of Good for Enterprise – Android does not support devices running the Android 1.5 or 1.6 OS. Good for Enterprise – Android v1.6.3 is the last client software version that supports devices running Android 1.5. Good for Enterprise – Android v1.6.5 is the last client software version that supports devices running Android 1.6.

Aging Policy and Memory Footprint

Good client currently limits the email storage to 3500 messages total in all folders.

If over 1750 emails, Good strips body content from older emails in order shown. If over 3500 emails, Good removes older emails until below 3500 emails.

- 1) Deleted items
- 2) Sent items
- 3) Folders under the inbox
- 4) Inbox

Initial OTA provisioning provides:

- Last 100 emails in inbox, sent and deleted items folders. For emails over 3 days old, headers only. Manually subscribed sub-folders under the Inbox behave the same.
- Calendar for 1 week in the past, and everything going forward, including all recurring meetings
- All contacts (tested up to 3500 contacts)

Total memory footprint:

Application: 16.6MB (compressed download file)

Runtime footprint: ~22.5 (no data)

Attachment cache: The larger of (1) 10MB or (2) size of last attachment downloaded

File repository: No limit.

Installation Note

Devices that have both cellular and wi-fi capability must have an active cellular account in order to be provisioned.

File Type and Security

Good for Enterprise – Android 1.6.5 and later supports the following file types for download: pdf, txt, wav, wma, wpd, htm, html, jsp, xml, bmp, gif, jpg, png, tif, tiff, xls, xlsx, pps, ppt, pptx, doc, docx, rtf, zip, 3gp, pdf, mp4, mp3.

Good for Enterprise now includes a built-in version of QuickOffice for viewing doc, docx, xls, xlsx, ppt, pptx, and txt files on the device. This version of QuickOffice has the “Save As” feature disabled, preventing these file types from being saved outside the secure enterprise container. Other file types can be opened only if the appropriate applications for doing so are installed on the device. Administrators can block access to these other file types through Good Mobile Control if they present a security risk.

Device Notes

The Kindle Fire disconnects from wi-fi when the screen goes off, to save battery. This is by design of the manufacturer (Amazon.com). Good will be unable to receive any data when wi-fi is disconnected. The only exception to wi-fi being turned off in such a manner is when the device is downloading a file or when a scheduled publication (magazine, e-book) delivery is ongoing.
